Here in the city we have a growing workforce of almost 120,000 people, and throughout National Careers Week, Skills Launchpad Plymouth is championing careers digitally at www.skillslaunchpadplym.co.uk, and through themed experiences, events and support sessions, around Plymouth's growth sectors.
